- Learning about First Nation Treaties as context for the historical elements of Treaties with the Crown, their relevance to the present and the future of the Treaty relationship;
- Demonstrating how K–12 Treaty education resources can effectively be integrated into the classroom and across subject areas;
- Developing an appreciation for the value of the spirit and intent of Treaties through experiential learning opportunities that includes a balance of the oral tradition and the written historical word, and classroom and land-based learning; and
- Examining how Treaty education can be used as a pedagogical tool for action and reconciliation in schools across Manitoba.

This specialized course is equivalent to a half-course (3 credit hours) at the post-secondary level. Accreditation provided by the Council of Elders, AMC and TRCM.
