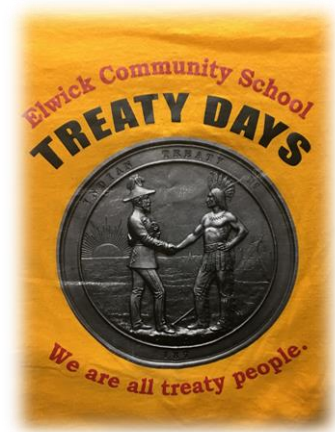

Overview:

Elwick is a grade K-8 school in Seven Oaks with a staff of 80 teachers and EAs.

Some of the Elwick staff were part of the early training, with one teacher a part of the pilot.

The presentations centred on basics of the Treaties; who, what, where, etc. They also wanted to know about the website and the various lessons that could be used at stations for their annual Treaty Days celebration at the end of May.

Prior to presenting to the staff, I met with the Indigenous Leadership team to share several of the K-8 lessons and lesson templates. I also reviewed the website to point out the supports available online.

The staff presentation was one hour of covering the history of the Treaties, the essential learnings and the supports on the website. It was only one hour to cover all the basics. The groups then split into breakout groups and those wanting the Treaty 101 presentation met with me. I did some hands-on lessons with them: symbols of the Treaty medal, the benefits and the Treaty map bingo.

The majority of the staff had not taken the TEI training so they were very interested in the information shared. Some are planning on taking the training if offered during the upcoming school year.
